About the Dedham School Committee

Pursuant to the Dedham Home Rule Charter, the School Committee shall have general and Superintendence of the public schools and, for this purpose, shall have all of the powers and duties which are given to School Committees under the constitution and the General Laws and such additional powers and duties as may be authorized by this charter, by by-law or by vote of the representative town meeting.

Meetings are the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays of the month, usually at 7:00 p.m.

Please note the School Committee policy for filling a vacancy: When a vacancy on the Dedham School Committee occurs for any reason, the Board of Selectmen and the remaining members of the Committee share the responsibility for filling it. As provided in the law, the School Committee will notify the Selectmen that a vacancy has been created within 30 days after it has occurred. For election to fill a vacancy, a candidate must receive a majority of the votes of the officers entitled to vote. The person so elected will fill the seat on the Committee until the next town election, at which time a member will be elected to serve the remainder of the term, if any.

How To Apply: Any interested person who desires to be considered for appointment for this position must respond between **August 10th and August 20th** by submitting a resume which sets forth the qualifications they hold for the position, and a letter expressing their interest in serving.
