# **SMART Goals for 2015-16**

Student blended/specialized learning - collaborative learning

Secure and provide funding to explore what 21st century skills are for but not limited to pre-K-12 learning. Connecting technology to personalized instructional practice, building a personalized culture and offering hands-on project based learning options, where students can build and participate and process and present their learning.

Start Times for all levels - review and possibly change

By the end of February 2016, a committee will be established including representatives from all stakeholder groups (parents, students, staff, community members, the athletic director, etc.) to collect benchmarking data regarding the most appropriate start times by grade level and recommend any appropriate changes to maximize student learning and well being.

Fund next phase of Free Full Day Kindergarten - Explore Pre-K

By the end of 2015, Dedham School Committee will continue discussions with stakeholders to establish the second stage to support funding and understanding of a free full day kindergarten program to open no later than the fall of 2018.

Support 20/20 Strategic Plan by March 1, 2016

To support the Superintendent in bringing the Strategic Plan (20/20 vision) to all stakeholders for their support and implement fully by March 1, 2016. Educate the community seek their input.

# ECEC at Dexter - support for favorable vote at Town Meeting

Superintendent's 2015-16 Goals

### Professional Practice Goal

- 1) Attend, participate in, and complete all 2015-16 NSIP requirements through day-long seminars and monthly consultations with assigned mentor.
- 2) Complete at least two principal observation visits to each school by March 31, 2016. Use principal observations to inform best practices and improve teacher effectiveness. Provide comprehensive feedback to all principals and directors during visits.
- 3) Complete at least one classroom visit in every single secondary teacher's classroom by May 15, 2016. Provide feedback in writing to all educators.
- 4) Conduct Senior Exit Interviews with groups of eight seniors every Tuesday and Thursday coordinated through X-block assignments. Survey all Seniors about their K-12 experiences and compile trends in responses for discussion with Leadership Team in May 2016.

### **Student Learning Goal**

1) Use District and individual school Data Teams to increase awareness of achievement performance in all schools. Focus individual School Improvement Plans on targeted areas of need based upon assessment feedback. Mandate specific, targeted improvement goals for all schools to be reported out to School Committee during SIP presentations in December 2015..

#### **District Improvement Goal**

- 1) Use five annual meetings of the Curriculum, Assessment, and Professional Development committees to integrate members from every school and department. Align FY17 budget priorities with CAPD initiatives to improve teacher and district capacity for increased student learning.
- 2) Work collaboratively with district leadership and Dedham Education Association as we integrate newly endorsed Supervision and Evaluation process to develop evaluator capacity and improve educator reflection and performance. Review all unannounced observations recorded through November 2015. Hold individual and group trainings with administrators to calibrate evaluator feedback and improve educator practice..
