DPS Return to In-Person Learning Family Survey

- Sent to all K-12 Families on Wednesday, March 10
- Daily follow-up since then...
 - Personal outreach family by family at K-8 level
 - 100% responses/connections at K-5
 - Continued trickle toward in-person

Current Timeline



- Full in person for all K-5 students as of Monday, April 5
- Full in person for all Gr. 6-8 students as of Monday, April 26
- Recommend Gr. 9-12 full in person on Monday, May 3
- Eliminate teacher simultaneous in-person + remote teaching at Grades PreK-8.
- Recommend Gr. 9-12 commitment to either in person or remote by Wednesday, April 28



Logistics

- Classroom space
 - No less than 3 feet of distancing between student seats
- Breakfast/lunch/snack
 - Will require at least 6 feet of distancing at all times
 - Outdoor eating whenever possible
 - Different solutions at each school (cafeterias or not)
 - Inclement weather contingencies
 - Use of gym for eating at Middle School
- Desks/materials
 - 200 desks purchased for K-5 classrooms (delivered 3/31)
 - 1000 lap trays for lunches
 - Additional curriculum materials for remote classes
- Remote Classroom Staffing
 - Use of instructional coaches, educational interventionists, and some new hires for Gr. K-5
 - Instructional Coaches, teachers on leave, Interventionists reassignment of content area educators at Gr. 6-8

Additional Considerations...



Continued Strict Enforcement of all COVID Protocols

- Masking at all times unless eating/mask break
- Sanitizing/hand washing many times per day
- Distancing whenever possible
- Continued enhanced COVID cleaning

Continued Emphasis on Pooled Testing Participation

- About 1000 tests/week as of today
- Shifting PreK-5 testing to once/week starting next week
- PreK-5 testing on Mondays
- DMS testing on Tuesdays
