## TREK 2017 Sessions

**Math:** Students will work with the online summer math assignment as one of the activities accomplished during this segment. Students will utilize the computer labs to build math skills through the use of math games and puzzles. Students will work in pairs and in small groups to enhance their understanding of the various middle school math concepts.

**Reading:** Students will work independently and in groups to complete a novel listed on their summer reading list. Along with the completion of the novel, the students will be involved in various activities (vocabulary building, literary elements, predictions, etc.) to enhance and stimulate their interest in reading.

**STEM:** Students will become directly involved in a variety of concepts driven to enhance their science, technology, engineering and math knowledge and prepare them for their upcoming year at DMS. Students will have available an assortment of STEM supplies and equipment in order to engage them in STEM activities and persuade them to “think outside of the box!”

**Creative Writing:** Students will work on shorter, paragraph length written pieces that focus more on the creative and fun aspects of writing.

**Enrichment:** The role of the Enrichment teacher is to facilitate the emotional and social development of middle school students. The session will involve activities which focus on teambuilding which will enhance and contribute to a student’s successful transition to and within the middle school.

**Recreation:** During this session students will participate in groups engaging in physical activities, including soccer, dodge ball, and basketball.

Dedham Public Schools continues to strive to meet the community needs by offering a summer program for students who will be entering DMS in the fall. This unit will reinforce the importance of daily physical activity.

The TREK teachers are experienced Math, Science, Reading, World History, Technology, World Language and English Teachers from all grade levels and an assortment of the DPS teams. By working with a variety of teachers in the Dedham Public Schools, TREK students will be given an opportunity to become familiar with different teachers, subjects and the school building before the first day of school. In addition, the TREK teachers will work directly with students to accomplish their summer reading and math.
